

Ranch Rules

1. An adult shall accompany any visitors under the age of 18, unless prior arrangements have been made. Anyone under the age of 18 may not enter the Property or Ranch without specific permission from Shannon or Gayle Oxford.
2. ANYONE who will be participating in Ranch activities must have a signed release form on record, NO exceptions.
3. Young children visiting need to be watched very closely and will need to follow all barn rules such as no running or yelling in barn, no entering pastures or stalls. Children must be under an adult's control at all times or they will be asked to leave immediately. **No climbing on haystack or bales.**
4. No visitors shall be allowed to enter the pastures at any time unless accompanied by an adult supervisor. This also applies to the horse stalls and paddocks.
5. Please do not bring your dogs to the Ranch. Please do not bring them and leave them in your vehicle either.
6. Please drive VERY SLOWLY while on the Ranch; watch for children and animals.
7. Please park in designated areas.
8. Kennel area is off limits.

Ranch Safety Rules:

1. **NO SMOKING ANYWHERE ON THE RANCH.**
2. All Stable safety rules are put into place to protect and keep everyone safe while here. Please follow all safety rules outline here or in the barn.
3. If Stable Safety rules are not followed you may be asked to leave the Ranch.
4. There will be no running or loud screaming/yelling in the barn or around the horses. If a horse gets loose please alert all others nearby and get any children out of harms way.
5. Anyone riding or mounting a horse under the age of 18 shall wear a helmet at all times. It is the suggestion and recommendation of the Ranch that ALL riders wear a helmet, heeled boots and any other protective gear deemed appropriate.
6. Participants shall keep the barn as neat and clean as possible, returning tack, rakes, tools etc. to their appropriate places. No items shall be left in the center isle or inside of stalls after use, where they can become a hazard to others using the facility.

Dress Code & Rules of Conduct

1. Appropriate clothing is a requirement. Riding jeans and a short or long sleeve top, T-shirts are ok, but no inappropriate logos or pictures. No open toed shoes or sandals. Boots with a heel for riding are recommended. If you do not have riding boots we may have a pair in your size to barrow. **No tank tops, strapless or thin strapped tops, no low cut jeans or midriff showing, no shorts or Capri pants.**
2. Children must be respectful at all times to all people including other children and their parents.
3. The children may call Gayle Oxford Miss Gayle or Mrs. Oxford, and they may call Shannon Oxford Mr. Oxford. All volunteers should be address accordingly E.I. Miss Chris or Miss or Mrs. (last name).
4. Children and parents must use appropriate language at all times.

Miscellaneous Rules:

1. Please do not stand on the fence rails or allow children to stand on the rails or swing on gates.
2. Be on time for your session. Please call at least one day prior if you need to cancel.
3. The Ranch, Shannon & Gayle Oxford, family and associates are not responsible for lost items. Please make sure you collect your belongings before leaving.
4. Absolutely no children allowed in the loft or on the balcony of the barn.
5. Please stay away from the Kennel area unless accompanied by the Owners.

Children and their families may be asked to leave or dismissed from the program for any inappropriate behavior or if these rules are not followed.
